Before I Die is a global art project that reimagines our relationship with death and with one another. We believe that talking about death helps us to fully live.

Our Before I Die wall is simply a chalkboard with the words “Before I die I want to _____.” stenciled over and over. It encourages people to contemplate death and reflect on their lives by writing their hopes, dreams and aspirations on a

public chalkboard. People approach the wall, consider and contribute. The words are serious and silly, inspirational and inane, sad and joyous.

“...go to all seven continents.” *“...learn to do the robot perfectly.”* *“...say I truly lived.”*
“...see a world I would be proud to leave to future generations.”
“...give a voice to the voiceless.” *“...win the lottery.”* *“...save a life.”*
